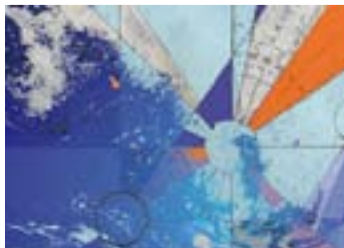


Patricia Wilson Smith

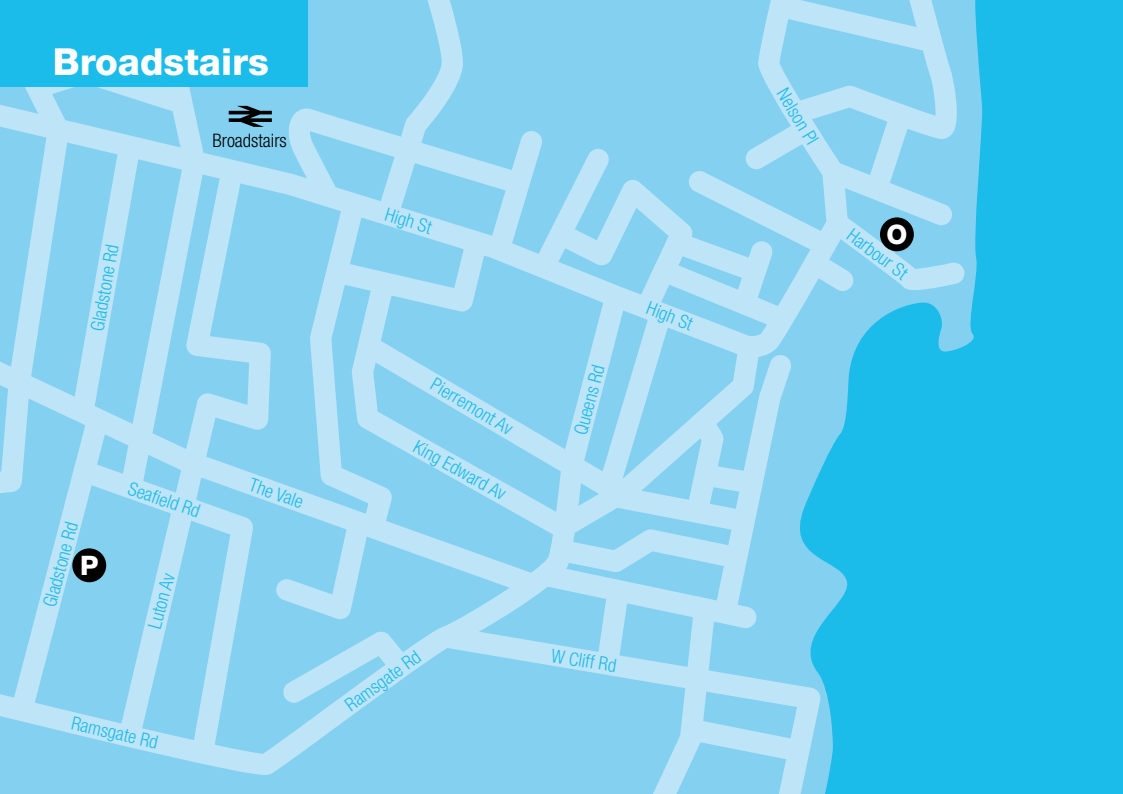
Jane Jones
